# Human Trafficking in the Netherlands


# **The National Rapporteur**

- Independent
- Founded in 2000
- Mandated by law to:
  - Research the nature and extent of trafficking in human beings and sexual violence against children in the Netherlands
  - Advise the government on preventing and combatting these offences
  - Periodically report to the government

## **Victims of Human Trafficking**


#### Estimate study:

- Annually 5,000-7,500
   victims of trafficking
- Only 668 possible victims reported in 2018



# Types of human trafficking


- Least visible type: domestic sexual exploitation
  - 3,000 victims
  - Nearly all women
  - Half of those victims (1,300) are minors
  - These minors are even less visible



- Domestic sexual exploitation
- Cross-border sexual exploitation
- Labour and criminal exploitation


#### **Sex of victims**

# **Challenges**


- Loss of insight on victimhood
  - Role of privacy regulations
  - Lacking comprehensive approach for young victims of sexual exploitation
- Phenomena not reflected in data
  - Forced prostitution of (LGBTQ+) boys
  - Domestic criminal exploitation and links with drugs and high impact crime
- The impact of large-scale migration
  - Organised migration from West-Africa and SEA
  - LGBTQ+ from Uganda
